What is data governance, really?

Strip away the jargon and data governance is simply this: knowing what data you hold, why you hold it, who's responsible for it, and making sure it's handled properly at every stage. It's not just a legal obligation — it's operational hygiene, the same way you'd expect proper financial controls or health and safety processes.

Why it matters commercially, not just legally

- **Trust:** customers, partners, and insurers increasingly ask about your data practices before they'll do business with you
- **Deal readiness:** poor data governance is one of the most common reasons due diligence drags on or valuations drop during a sale or investment round
- **Risk reduction:** a data breach or ICO enforcement action can cost far more in reputation and management time than in the fine itself
- **Efficiency:** knowing where your data lives and who owns it removes friction from everyday operations, from onboarding new staff to responding to customer queries
- **Competitive edge:** many tenders and partnership agreements now require evidence of data governance maturity as a condition of doing business

The cost of getting it wrong

Most enforcement action and data incidents at SMEs don't stem from malicious behaviour — they stem from nobody being clearly accountable, no one knowing what data exists, and processes that were never written down. These are entirely preventable with modest, proportionate investment.

Where to start

- Identify what personal data you hold and why (start with our Data Asset Register template)
- Assign clear ownership for each area (see our RACI template)
- Benchmark where you are today (try our Maturity Self-Assessment)
